

PET LICENSE APPLICATION

In Orange County, all dogs over the age of four (4) months are required by law to be licensed and vaccinated against rabies. Residents owning or having custody of any dog must license the dog within 15 days of acquisition or within 15 days after the license becomes due (Anaheim residents have 30 days). Residents must provide proof of a California approved rabies vaccination to obtain a license (OCCO 4-1-70).

Each contract city within the County has different zoning requirements regarding the number of animals it allows per property. The majority of cities served by OC Animal Care and unincorporated county areas require pet owners to obtain an Animal Permit from OC Animal Care for properties that keep or maintain more than 3 cats and/or 3 dogs. Some contract cities have zoning requirements that do not allow for Animal Permits in their city. It is your responsibility to be familiar with your city's zoning requirements. - ➔ **Proof of age for the Senior Citizen's Discount** (if applicable)
